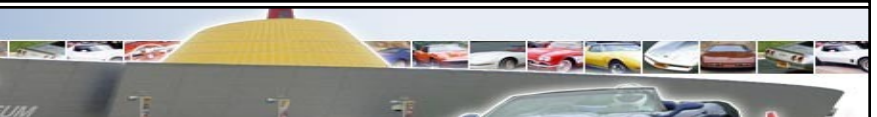

And Hall of Fame Induction  
September 2-4, 2010

**The National Corvette Museum** has opened the registration pages on their website for the Hall of Fame induction. If you are planning to attend the induction of CCWP member Grady Davis and intend to sit with fellow CCWP members, there is a special way you will have to register.

You will need to contact Pat Hillyard to let him know you are going, and send him a check in the amount \$55.00 per person attending by July 6th. The museum will only allow us to reserve tables in groups of ten. This will get you into the Museum and the Hall of Fame event and special souvenirs. If you plan on attending the other activities being hosted by the Museum, go to their website [www.corvettemuseum.com](http://www.corvettemuseum.com) and register on their events page for the Anniversary Celebration . **DO NOT REGISTER FOR THE HALL OF FAME INDUCTION**, only those other events that you wish to participate in.

We will be staying at the Sleep Inn. Call (270) 842-3800 to make your hotel reservations. The room rates are \$76.49 for a King size bed and \$84.99 for two Queen size beds. Our block of rooms are under the name Corvette Club of Western Pennsylvania.

*A Call to Cars.....* The fact that you are reading this message indicates an involvement with an exceptional car club, the Corvette Club of Western PA. An organization that is long on history, with very deep roots in the very perpetuation of America's iconic sports car, the Corvette. We are currently in position to pay homage to two pillars of CCWP's historical foundation, Donna Mae Mims and Grady Davis. This note is a call for Club members and friends to be part of these celebrations.

On July 24 and 25, the Pittsburgh Vintage Grand Prix will pay tribute to former Lifetime Member Donna Mae by featuring Corvette as the "spotlight" car this year. Early negotiations with the PVGP resulted in getting us a more than reasonable fee for Corvette parking and to actually be included in a commemorative parade on the race course as part of the tribute. Pre-registration fees are just \$25.00 for TWO days of parking, with another \$10.00 for the parade. This is *the* bargain car event of the summer, at what is by far *the* best Pittsburgh region civic event during the summer months. As part of this year's 16<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Corvette Museum Labor Day Celebration, former CCWP member, and former Vice-President of Gulf Oil Company, O.Grady Davis, will be inducted into the Corvette Hall of Fame in Bowling Green. Mr. Davis will become the *third* CCWP member to be so honored. Of the hundreds of Corvette clubs in the country (and world), no others have achieved this noteworthy distinction. As a point of reference, this is on a par with the Steelers winning a 7<sup>th</sup> Super Bowl. At last count, we have nearly two tables signed up for the induction dinner. That translates to 10 couples. If there was ever a time to show up and show your colors on a national stage, this is that time. I'm not asking you to even sign up for the complete weekend, just the induction dinner. And if you don't care to stay in Bowling Green hotels, you are only 45 minutes from Nashville.
